

Finalists announced for Sikuville Awards

The Sikuville Journalism Awards 2018 has announced the finalists in 13 of the 17 categories that exists and out of 350 entries received this year.

The winners will be announced at the prize-giving function on 13 September 2018. Winners receive R15,000, a trophy and a certificate. All finalists receive certificates. Commendation Certificates are awarded at the judges' discretion.

Categories 14 to 17 will only be announced on the evening. The categories are Category 14: SA Story of the year, Category 15: Upcoming/ rising star of the year, Category 16: Journalist of the year and Category 17: Allan Kirkland Soga Lifetime Achiever Award.
