

Bloomberg: Dan Marokane to succeed Andre de Ruyter as permanent Eskom CEO

Dan Marokane is expected to be named CEO of Eskom, <u>Bloomberg News reported</u> on Thursday, citing unnamed sources. Spokespeople for Eskom and the Department of Public Enterprises, the government department that oversees the power company, declined to comment on the Bloomberg report.
