

Ugandan reporter takes top honours

Investigative reporter for the Weekly Observer in Uganda, Richard Kavuma outstripped more than 1500 other African journalists to lift CNN's/Multichoice's African Journalist of the Year in Cape Town at the weekend.

Cape Town - Kavuma was recognised for his work on Uganda's progress towards the UN's Millennium Development Goals. Kavuma started his career as a freelance journalist with *The Monitor* newspaper in 1996. He has since graduated to a senior staff writer on the *Weekly Observer* concentrating his efforts on investigative work, peace, conflict and human rights reporting. He is a graduate of Makerere University.
