

Galaxy TV launches on DStv

MultiChoice Nigeria has added Galaxy TV, a popular free to air (FTA) channel from Lagos, to its DStv platform from Thursday, 7 July 2016.



Galaxy TV will broadcast current news from Nigeria, Africa and the rest of the world and will be on DStv channel 258. The channel will be available to Premium, Compact Plus, Compact, Family and Access subscribers.
